2016 Staffing Levels – Uphoff stated that according to state statute it is the County Board that establishes the number of Assistant States Attorneys he is allowed to have. Uphoff stated that currently he is approved for four. Uphoff stated that he has an Assistant that will be taking military leave for approximately five months. Uphoff stated that he would like the flexibility to cover the leave and any other issues which may arise, at his discretion, which may include utilizing contracts, part time assistants and/or use of special prosecutors. Uphoff stated that he in no way intends to exceed his approved budget allocation or the previously approved staffing level of four full time equivalents. Discussion took place. *Motion by Bunting, second by Vietti to approve up to eight Assistant States Attorneys, not to exceed the annual budget allocation.* **MOTION CARRIED WITH ALL AYES.**
