Dear Mr. Parzcyk,

Pursuant to your request, the intent of this letter is to discuss complaints that Streator-Cayuga Ridge Wind Power LLC, a wholly-owned subsidiary of Iberdrola Renewables, LLC ("SCRS") has received regarding the Streator Cayuga Ridge South Project (the "Project") located in Union, Odell, and Saunemin Townships, Livingston County, IL.

The Project commenced construction in October 2008 and achieved commercial operations in March 2010. During the construction of the project SCRS received a small number of complaints related to construction activities such as dust generation and traffic coordination and communication issues. These issues were addressed and resolved by SCRS.

After achievement of commercial operations, our records show that SCRS received fewer than 10 complaints regarding the Project. One of the most common issues was related to potential interference with television reception. In each case, SCRS resolved the matter by adjusting the landowner's television services. One landowner also expressed concerns about selling a house during hearings in Livingston County related to Iberdrola Renewables' Streator Deer Run project. In 2011, the landowner's house was successfully sold.

Since March 2011, SCRS has not received any complaints about the Project from residents in the Project area.
