I wanted to follow up on our correspondence about MET tower markings. In your last e-mail, you recommended that we place more yellow sleeves above the lower marker balls on MET towers. I checked into this with our Logistics Manager and she confirmed that it is possible to add another sleeve. Pleasant Ridge will now plan to have another sleeve of guy guards above the lower marker balls on the permanent MET tower that will go up once the project is operational.

Thank you for sending the pictures. I have only one suggestion for you. The yellow "sleeves" around the supporting cables will be difficult/impossible to see when the surrounding crops are fully grown; especially corn. Adding another sleeve just above the lowest balls will certainly help. Keep in mind that the aircraft will be applying at a height of approximately 15 feet high.

Please forgive the delay but I just got back from the National Agricultural Aviation Association Conference and Tradeshow and am finally catching up with correspondence.

I do appreciate the contact you initiated back in October and the project information you subsequently sent to me. I think it is very important to keep the lines of communication open between the wind energy proponents and those of us who are impacted by those developments. As you are aware, the met towers are vital to your industry yet are of considerable danger because they are so hard to see. We have a mutual desire not to see them hit by aircraft so keeping emphasis on adequate marking is of the utmost importance. Several states have passed legislation stipulating exactly how the towers are to be marked. We have not seen the need to push for that action here in Illinois because we have not met with resistance to suitable markings. We certainly hope that cooperation continues.
