a. <u>Local Agency Agreement for Federal Participation</u>: Federal-Aid Agreement for replacement of Structure No. 053-3254 in Owego Road District. Includes Resolution appropriating County Aid to Bridge Funds for Local Agency share of cost.

**CLOSED SESSION MINUTES:** Motion by Weller, second by Runyon to approve the content and open the closed session minutes of the November 10, 2016 meeting; and to destroy the recordings of closed session minutes older than 18 months. MOTION CARRIED WITH ALL AYES

**OTHER ITEMS:** Metcalf shared that three employees so far have opted to take the early retirement package offered by the County. Two of the positions have been posted internally and advertised with an April 14, 2017 deadline to receive applications. Gutters are in need of replacement for the office building so installation has been scheduled. Metcalf explained the need to update the survey equipment used by the technical staff. This need was discussed at the time of budget preparation and a quote for a new total station was shared with the committee. Another budgeted item discussed was a new tandem axle snow plow truck. Options to make this purchase were given with no action being taken at this time. IDOT recently posted two bridges due to them being re-evaluated as part of FHWA Metric 13 requirements. Recent bridge inspections of County Highway structures also revealed some concerns that could result in an IDOT posting.
