THE LOCATION OF YOUR POLLING PLACE HAS CHANGED

Enclosed you will find a new voter registration card(s) for each member of your family, who is a registered voter in Forrest Township. These are being issued as the result of a change in the location of your election day polling site from the Forrest Public Library to the Village Hall.

This **new location** has been designated by the Livingston County Board as the place for holding primary, general, consolidated and special elections for your township precinct.

The polling place for **Forrest Township has been moved** from the Forrest Library at 301 W James Street, Forrest to:

Please make sure you are registered at your current address; you cannot vote if you are not properly registered. You may change your address by completing the back of your voter registration card and mailing it to the Livingston County Clerk's Office.

If you are unable to vote at the polls on Election Day (November 6, 2018), there are other options available. You may come into this office to early or grace period vote or you may contact this office for an application for a Vote By Mail ballot.
