Qualifications: Candidate must be a registered voter and shall not be a child sex offender as defined in Section 11-9.3 of the Criminal Code of 2012 [105 ILCS 5/10-10] and must be a U.S. citizen of the age of 18 or over and a resident of the State and the school district for 1 year preceding the election.

First day to circulate petitions: Tuesday, September 18, 2018

Signature Requirement Minimum: 50

Except for Rooks Creek Community Consolidated School District # 425: 39

When & Where to File: Monday, December 10, 2018 - Monday, December 17, 2018

8:30 AM - 4:30 PM, Monday - Friday

What to File:

The following *original* documents shall be filed:

1. Statement of Candidacy (P-1A) - notarized and same spelling of name as on the nominating petitions.
2. *Nominating Petitions (P-7) - numbered, notarized and same spelling of name as on the Statement of Candidacy. (This form may be copied before circulation)
 - *The petition signature sheets must be numbered consecutively, beginning with the top sheet as number "1".
 - *The petition signature sheets must be neatly fastened together in book form by fastening them together at one edge in a secure and suitable manner.
3. Receipt from filing the Statement of Economic Interest form.
4. Loyalty Oath (P-1C).
5. * Certification of Deletions Form (P-2A) only if signatures are struck.
 - *The circulator or candidate may strike signatures from the petition sheets prior to filing. The person striking the signature must initial the petition at the place where the signature is struck and complete the Certificate of Deletions form listing the page and line of each struck signature.

Candidates may file in person, by mail or may have someone else file on their behalf.
