PRAIRIE MATERIALS REQUEST on CH 10: Metcalf shared that Prairie Material has approached the Highway Department about crossing the Weston Road at 1125N or 1100N. After discussions with State's Attorney, Randy Yedinak and Zoning Administrator, Chuck Schopp and Chairman Bunting it was agreed that 1125N is the preferred crossing location. It was determined that an agreement or permit could be developed to allow overweight/oversized haul trucks to cross the road. This has been relayed to Prairie Material and they are exploring the possibility of crossing at 1125N vs. 1100N.

OTHER ITEMS: The committee discussed moving the monthly meeting day to Wednesday's at 3:30 pm for the upcoming 2019 calendar year. Hartley state that the 2019 calendar is not finalized yet but this change should be acceptable. Metcalf shared that IACE Revenue & Legislative Committee met this past month to develop a collaborative Transportation Needs 2109 statement for our State legislators when or if new funding is introduced.
