PROPOSITION TO AUTHORIZE A NEW TAX RATE

SHALL LIVINGSTON COUNTY, ILLINOIS, BE AUTHORIZED TO LEVY A NEW TAX FOR SENIOR CITIZEN SOCIAL SERVICES, SPECIFICALLY THE LIVINGSTON COUNTY COMMUNITY HEALTHCARE PROGRAM, AND HAVE AN ADDITIONAL TAX OF 0.025% OF THE EQUALIZED ASSESSED VALUE OF THE TAXABLE PROPERTY THEREIN EXTENDED FOR SUCH PURPOSES?

SHALL THE LIMITING RATE UNDER THE PROPERTY TAX EXTENSION LIMITATION LAW FOR LIVINGSTON COUNTY, ILLINOIS, BE INCREASED BY AN ADDITIONAL AMOUNT EQUAL TO 0.025% ABOVE THE LIMITING RATE FOR THE PURPOSE OF SUPPORTING SENIOR CITIZEN SOCIAL SERVICES, SPECIFICALLY THE LIVINGSTON COUNTY COMMUNITY HEALTHCARE PROGRAM FOR THE LEVY YEAR 2018 AND BE EQUAL TO 1.01586% OF THE EQUALIZED ASSESSED VALUE OF THE TAXABLE PROPERTY THEREIN FOR LEVY YEAR 2020?

(1)The approximate amount of taxes extendable at the most recently extended limiting rate is \$7,301,703.56 and the approximate amount of taxes extendable if the proposition is approved is \$7,485,929.98.
(2)For the 2020 levy year the approximate amount of the additional tax extendable against property containing a single family residence and having a fair market value at the time of the referendum of \$100,000 is estimated to be \$15.62.
(3)If the proposition is approved, the aggregate extension for 2020 will be determined by the limiting rate set forth in the proposition, rather than the otherwise applicable limiting rate calculated under the provisions of the Property Tax Extension Limitation Law (commonly known as the Property Tax Cap Law).
