### **NOTICE TO LIVINGSTON COUNTY REGISTERED VOTERS**

Due to concerns over COVID-19 a new law, SB1863, has been enacted through the Illinois Legislature for the November 3, 2020 Election only. The bill states that each Election Authority in Illinois must send each person that voted in the 2018 General Election, 2019 Consolidated Election or 2020 Primary Election an application to vote by mail. Livingston County will be sending an application to all the registered voters in our county. If you are registered, you should automatically receive this Vote by Mail Application that is to be mailed no later than August 1, 2020 in postcard form. **You are not required to vote by mail** but this gives you the opportunity if you choose to.

As with any election, all registered voters still have the following voting options:

1. **Vote at your polling place** on Tuesday, November 3, 2020
2. **Vote Early in the County Clerk's Office** - September 24th through November 2nd
3. **Vote by Mail** - Application may be made now through October 29, 2020
