

ORDINANCE AMENDING ORDINANCE NO. 2011-00-00  
REAPPORTIONING LIVINGSTON COUNTY BOARD  
ORDINANCE No. 2021-06-\_\_\_\_\_

LET IT BE RESOLVED by the Livingston County Board that the following changes be made in the Ordinance Reapportioning Livingston County for the election of County Board members as follows:

1. Effective the first Monday in December 2022 said County Board shall consist of eighteen (18) members, six (6) each to be elected from three (3) County Board Districts as described hereafter.
2. The three (3) County Board Districts shall consist of:
  - a. District One- all of Rooks Creek and Pontiac Township.
  - b. District Two- all of Reading, Newtown, Sunbury, Nevada, Dwight, Round Grove, Long Point, Amity, Esmen, Odell, Union, Broughton and Owego townships
  - c. District Three- all of Nebraska, Waldo, Pike, Eppards Point, Saunemin, Sullivan, Avoca, Pleasant Ridge, Charlotte, Indian Grove, Forrest, Chatsworth, Belle Prairie, Fayette and Germanville Townships
3. The chairman of said County Board shall be elected by the members of said County Board for a two year term commencing the first Monday in December 2022 each succeeding chairman of said Board shall serve a two year term and would be elected in the same manner. If a vacancy in the office of chairman of said Board should occur, the members of said Board shall elect one of them to serve for the balance of the unexpired term of said chairman.
4. The salary of the members of said Board shall be computed on per diem basis of \$45.00 per day. In addition, the chairman of said Board shall receive an additional per diem of \$35.00 per day, or a total of \$80.00 per diem.
5. The members of said Board elected in November 2022, shall determine by lot which half of their membership shall serve for a two (2) year term and which half shall serve a four (4) year term. Their successors shall be elected to the same terms as the original office holder.
6. If a vacancy on said Board occurs, said vacancy shall be filled by appointment by the remaining members of said Board within sixty (60) days thereafter, said appointment to be effective until next election of County Board members, at which time an election shall be held to fill said vacancy for the unexpired term.

7. If any provision or clause of this Ordinance or application thereof to any person or circumstance is held invalid, said invalidity shall not affect other provisions, clauses or applications of the Ordinance which can be given effect without the invalid provision, clause or application, and to this end, the provisions and clauses of the Ordinance are declared to be severable.
