The following is notice pursuant to the Livingston County Zoning Ordinance (Sec. 56, Code of Ordinances, Livingston County, Illinois, including without limitation Article VIII - Wind Energy and Sec. 56-622) ninety (90) days or more in advance of an anticipated permit application by Livingston Wind Project, LLC, a Delaware limited liability company ("LWP"), for siting and special use approval to construct, erect, install, and locate wind towers and a Wind Energy Conversion System (WECS) Project identified as the Livingston Wind Project (the "Project") in Livingston County, along with variations and such other waivers and approvals as are required for the Project.

LWP will be hosting an Open House community meeting regarding the Project from 4:30-7:00 p.m. on Tuesday February 8th at Tri-Point High School at 100 East Van Alstyne Street, Cullom, Illinois 60929. All interested persons are invited to attend the Open House to learn more about the Project and to provide feedback to project developers. If applicable rules change so as to prohibit in person public gatherings, like the Open House at the location above, then a link to a virtual on-line Open House will be posted on the Project webpage identified below.

LWP is an affiliate of EDF Renewables, Inc. ("EDFR"), a market leading independent power producer and service provider with 35 years of experience. EDFR and its affiliates build, own and operate renewable energy power plants across North America, including the nearby Kelly Creek and Pilot Hill Wind Farms in Ford, Iroquois and Kankakee Counties. LWP is in the process of developing the Project, an approximately 255 MW wind farm located primarily in Broughton and Sullivan Townships. The Project may also include up to three turbines in the northeast quarter of Union Township, all located within a half mile of the Township's eastern border. The Project may additionally include up to four turbines and a substation in Round Grove Township, all within a mile of the Township's southern border. Hundreds of your neighbors in Livingston County, representing approximately 29,000 acres of land, are participating in the Project in these areas.
