Resolution Opposing HB5855 - The Committee reviewed a resolution opposing Illinois General Assembly HB5855 Protect Illinois Communities Act. Committee member Jim Blackard requested that a sentence be added stating, “Whereas, HB5855 is a violation of the 4th amendment to the US Constitution requiring persons to relinquish lawfully owned Arms & Ammunition.” Discussion took place. *Motion by Blackard, second by Fannin to recommend approval of the resolution as amended. MOTION CARRIED WITH ALL AYES.*

Other Reports as Needed - Jim Blackard informed the Committee that the VAC 2013 Dodge Grand Caravan has been sold.
