Special Provisions

The following Special Provisions supplement the "Standard Specifications for the Road and Bridge Construction," adopted January 1, 2022, the "Supplemental Specifications and Recurring Special Provisions," adopted January 1, 2024 (as indicated on the check sheet included herein), and the latest edition of the "Illinois Manual on Uniform Traffic Control Devices for Streets and Highways" in effect on the date of invitation for bids. These special provisions included herein apply to and govern the proposed improvement designated as Section 24-00000-00-GM / FOB Quarry or Plant and in case of conflict with any part or parts of said specifications, said special provisions shall take precedent and shall govern.

Proposal Guaranty:

A proposal guaranty **will not** be required.

Aggregate:

The material called for in this proposal will be used for patching County Highways in Patrol No. 1 in Livingston County during the fiscal year ending December 31, 2024. The successful bidder agrees to furnish material at the listed price during the entire fiscal year. The material will be used only if the roads need to be patched. It is possible that no materials, whatsoever, will be used. No material listed in this proposal shall be furnished after December 31, 2024.

Aggregate Surface Course, Type B shall conform to the specifications set forth in Article 1004.04 of the Standard Specifications and shall be grade number CA-6 or CA-10. The plasticity index shall NOT exceed 6 if crushed stone is furnished. The plasticity index shall be between 2 and 6 if gravel is furnished.

Seal Coat Aggregate: The material shall meet the minimum requirements of Article 1004.01, Quality Designation "C". Gradation shall be CA-16.

***(Limestone Chips Only)**

Blotter Aggregate: The material shall meet the minimum requirements of Article 1003.01, Quality Designation "C". Gradation shall be FA-6.

***(Limestone Chips Only)**

Riprap:

Stone Riprap A3: The material shall meet the minimum requirements of Article 1005.01(b), Quality Designation "A". Gradation shall be RR 3. In lieu of RR 3, material ranging in dimension from 4" to 8" will also be allowed with prior approval of the County Engineer.

Stone Riprap A4: The material shall meet the minimum requirements of Article 1005.01(b), Quality Designation "A". Gradation shall be RR 4. Quarry Run material may be used in lieu of RR 4 providing excessively large pieces are culled from the stockpile prior to loading trucks.

GENERAL NOTES FOR AGGREGATES:

1. It is hereby understood that the quantities listed are approximate only and that they may be increased or decreased one hundred percent.
2. Engineer: The Engineer shall be the County Engineer of Livingston County or his authorized representative. All material shall be of a quality approved by the Engineer and his word shall be final in approving or rejecting the material.
3. It is understood and agreed that payment will be made on the basis of 100% of the material furnished each month. The total tons of material shall be computed from weights taken from the quarry tickets. Each truckload of material shall be weighed to the nearest 100 pounds.
4. Type B Surface Course, CA-3, Riprap, Blotter Aggregate and Seal Coat Aggregate may be purchased from any quarry which submits a bid. The combination of the price of the material, the length of haul to any particular delivery point and the availability of the material will determine the quarry from which the material will be purchased. The unit price of **\$0.20** per ton per mile will be used to determine the cost of hauling. The material will be purchased from the quarry which will be most advantageous to the County.
5. The unit price bid by the supplier shall be his price per ton of gravel or crushed stone loaded in trucks at the quarry. The supplier shall indicate in his proposal the location where the material will be loaded in the trucks.

HMA Surface Course, Mix C, N50 & HMA Binder Course, IL 19.0:

The material called for in this proposal will be used for patching bituminous surfaced County Highways in Patrol No. 1 in Livingston County during the year ending December 31, 2024. The successful bidder or bidders agree(s) to furnish the material F.O.B. County trucks at the listed price during 2024 when the plant is in operation. No material shall be furnished after December 31, 2024.

1. The Contractor shall use a Bituminous Mixture meeting the requirements as specified in Section 406.
2. It is hereby understood and agreed that the quantities listed are approximate only and may be increased or decreased 100%.
3. Engineer: The Engineer shall be the County Engineer of Livingston County or his authorized representative. All material shall be of a quality approved by the Engineer and his word shall be final in approving or rejecting any material.

4. It is understood and agreed that payment will be made on the basis of 100% of the material furnished each month. The total tons of material shall be computed from weights taken from plant tickets. Each truck-load of material shall be weighed to the nearest 100 pounds.
5. Material may be purchased from any supplier that submits a bid. The combination of the price of the material, the length of the haul to a particular delivery point and the availability of the material at the time needed will determine the plant location from which the material will be purchased. The unit price of **\$0.20** per ton per mile will be used to determine the cost of hauling. The material will be purchased from the plant which will be most advantageous to Livingston County when the above is considered.
