- It is understood and agreed that the "Standard Specifications for Road and Bridge Construction", adopted 01/01/22 and the "Supplemental Specifications and Recurring Special Provisions", adopted 01/01/24, prepared by the Department of Transportation, shall govern insofar as they may be applied and insofar as they do not conflict with the special provision and supplemental specifications attached hereto.
- It is understood that quantities listed are approximate only and that they may be increased or decrease as may be needed to properly complete the improvement within its present limits or extensions thereto, at the unit prices stated and that bids will be compared on the basis of total price bid for each group.
- Delivery in total or partial shipments as ordered shall be made within the time specified in the special provisions or by the acceptance at the point and in the manner specified in the "Schedule of Prices". If delivery on the job site is specified, it shall mean any place or paces on the road designed by the awarding authority or its authorized representative.
- The contractor and/or local public agency performing the actual material placement operations shall be responsible for providing work zone traffic control, unless otherwise specified in this proposal. Such devices shall meet the requirements of and be installed in accordance with applicable provisions of the "Illinois Manual on Uniform Traffic Control Devices" and any referenced Illinois Highway Standards.

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5. Each pay item should have a unit price and a total price. If no total price is shown or if there is a discrepancy between the product of the unit price multiplied by the quantity, the unit price shall govern. The following Special Provisions supplement the "Standard Specifications for Road and Bridge Construction", Adopted January 1, 2022, the latest edition of the "Manual on Uniform Traffic Control Devices for Streets And Highways", and the "Manual of Test Procedures of Materials" in effect on the date of invitation of bids, and the Supplemental Specifications and Recurring Special Provisions indicated on the Check Sheet included here in which apply to and govern the construction of 24-00000-00-GM / Combined Culverts, and in case of conflict with any part, or parts, of said Specifications, the said Special Provisions shall take precedence and shall govern.

GENERAL REQUIREMENTS:

The quantities bid are estimates for bidding purposes only. The actual quantities will vary. **Delivery of pipes is to be within 3 weeks of the verbal or the written order dates.** Pipes will be ordered in various quantities from individual pipe to several pipes to a truckload throughout the year. Pipes will be delivered to various job sites and yards within Livingston County, although the majority will be delivered to the Livingston County Highway Department in Pontiac, IL. All billing and payment will be through Livingston County Highway Department.

Proposal guarantees for all but the successful bidder will be returned the day of the letting. The successful bidder's proposal guarantee will be returned at the end of the year upon receipt of the herein specified items within the time limit specified and upon evidence of the required inspection. **FAILURE ON THE PART OF THE SUCCESSFUL BIDDER TO DELIVER THE HEREIN SPECIFIED ITEMS WITHIN THE TIME PERIOD SPECIFIED OR TO FURNISH THE SPECIFIED ITEMS WILL BE CONSIDERED JUST CAUSE TO FORFEIT HIS PROPOSAL GUARANTEE AND CANCEL THE CONTRACT.** Should the County elect not to cancel the contract and decide to accept the material Article 108.09 "Failure to Complete the Work on Time" will apply unless an extension of time is granted as explained in Article 108.08(b).

Unbalanced bids will be rejected.

All pipes shall include **Mill Certifications** when shipped or invoiced.

All pipe culverts shall be standard 2 2/3" x 1/2" corrugations, except 3" x 1" corrugations shall be used on the sized indicated in the proposal.

All pipe shall be annular riveted.

All bands shall be annular and match the pipe furnished, and will be fabricated from the same type base metal and have the same protective coating as is used for the pipe. **The bolt connectors shall be individual "tabs" and separate from one another on any given band and attached to the band with two rivets. Single piece angle-steel bolt connectors will not be allowed.**

Rolled ends will be required on a portion of the pipe ordered from 10" – 30" diameter.

Bands 10" – 15" in diameter shall be 1 foot wide and have 2 bolt connectors and will be paid for as 1 foot of pipe.

Bands 18" – 54" in diameter shall be 2 foot wide and have 4 bolt connectors and will be paid for as 2 foot of pipe.

Bands 60" and larger shall be 3 feet wide and have 6 bolt connectors and will be paid for as 3 feet of pipe.

All pipe designated as \_\_\_\_\_ CSCP \_\_\_\_\_ thick galvanized shall be Galvanized Corrugated Steel Culvert Pipe conforming to Sec. 1006.01(b) of the Standard Specifications.
