



TRAFFIC SAFETY SCHOOL FREQUENTLY ASKED QUESTIONS

How do I complete my traffic safety school requirement?	Traffic safety school is typically completed online. There are currently no in-person traffic safety school options available in or near Livingston County.
How long is the class?	Unless otherwise ordered by the court, your class must be four hours long.

How long do I have to complete my class?	Your due date can be found on the Order you received at the time you were sentenced. If you have any questions about your due date, contact the Livingston County Circuit Clerk's Office at (815) 844-2602.
What do I do once I complete my class?	<p>You must print off the certificate of completion from your class and deliver the certificate to the Livingston County Circuit Clerk's Office at the address below.</p> <p>***The traffic safety school provider <u>WILL NOT</u> send your certificate of completion to the court. It is your responsibility to make sure this certificate is on file with the Circuit Clerk prior to your due date.***</p>
What happens if I don't complete traffic safety school by my due date?	<p>If you are on court supervision for a <u>petty traffic</u> offense ("TR" case number), your court supervision will be revoked and a conviction will enter for the offense to which you were sentenced.</p> <p>If you are on court supervision, conditional discharge, or probation for a <u>major traffic/misdemeanor</u> offense ("MT" or "CM" case number), the State's Attorney's Office could file a Petition to Revoke or a Contempt petition, in which case you would be summoned to appear in court for further proceedings. If you fail to appear in court as directed, a warrant could be issued for your arrest.</p>
